#### **EDUCATION:**

Caleb graduated from the University of Scranton in 2008 with his Master's in Physical Therapy. Since that time he has maintained a strong interest in orthopedics. Caleb was a high school and college athlete and performed clinical training with the San Francisco Giants. In 2014 Caleb obtained his Board Certification as an Orthopedic Clinical Specialist (OCS) recognizing his advanced knowledge in the field of Orthopedics.

Caleb continued his pursuit of education obtaining his Doctorate in Physical Therapy from Temple University in 2016. He recently received his Certificate of Orthopedic Manual Therapy (COMT) after taking numerous courses related to mobilization and manipulation.
